## Memorial Health to Expand Healthcare Access in Athens

**Athens, OH (October 28, 2021)** — Memorial Health System continues to expand available services in Athens, Ohio, and surrounding areas to allow residents to receive local care and see specialists close to home instead of traveling to Columbus or beyond. All our providers collaborate in the best interest of our patients across specialties.

Currently, Athens residents have access to our Athens Department of Primary Care for all their primary care needs, as well as our Athens Department of Specialty Care, which includes cardiology; general surgery; orthopedic surgery; ear, nose & throat; podiatry; and Lifestyle Medicine.

Coming in November, we are also adding Departments of Orthopedics, Obstetrics & Gynecology, and Osteopathic Manipulative Medicine. Memorial Health System has an excellent partnership with Ohio University and Ohio University Heritage College of Osteopathic Medicine and looks forward to deepening that relationship and offering services to the entire community.

As the health system grows access to the region, it plans to open a freestanding emergency department on Columbus Road in July 2022. The ED will be fully equipped with technology and resources including CT scanning, ultrasound, lab services and X-ray services. Patients will be able to receive treatment for a range of emergency conditions including chest pain, stroke, trauma injuries, severe pain, broken bones, cuts, burns and more. Should a condition require additional advanced treatment, surgery or inpatient care, patients would be stabilized and transported to the Marietta Memorial Hospital main campus.

Memorial Health System is experienced in providing top-rated care at freestanding ERs. In fact, our Belpre freestanding emergency room has been recognized for care rating in the top 10% in the nation for patient satisfaction.

The 20,000 square foot facility will cost about \$20 million and will bring an additional 50 jobs to the 50 that have already been added to the community.
